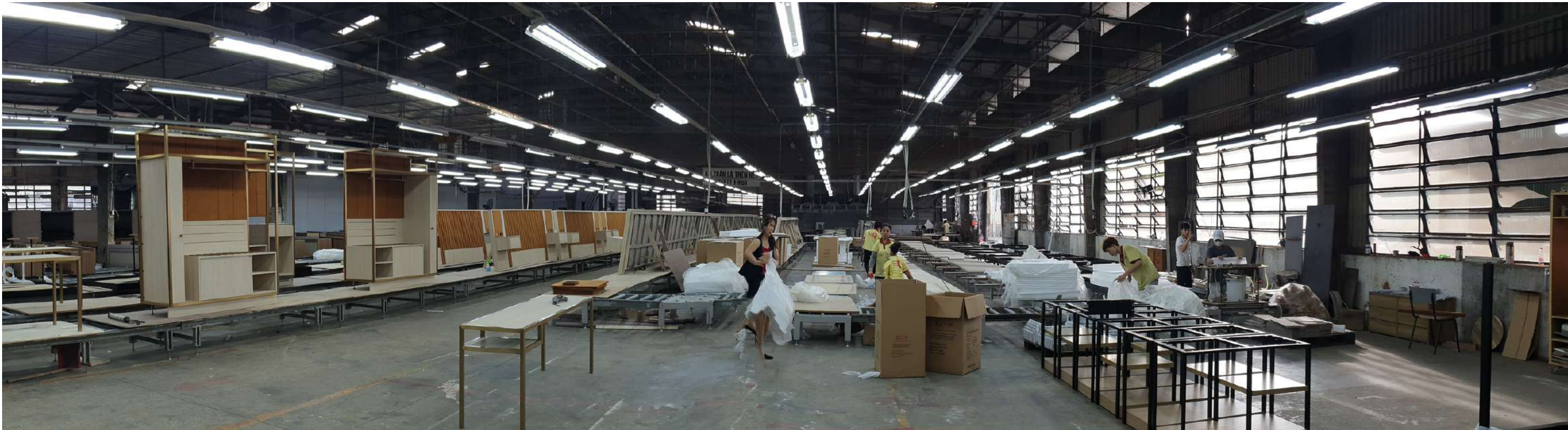


PRODUCTION PROCESS and FACILITY

1. Sourcing

The quality of our products is determined by the raw materials used to make it, the precision of its engineering and the care taken to make it.

We work with a wide range of materials from **Walnut, Oak** hardwoods to engineered wood materials.



PRODUCTION PROCESS and FACILITY

2. Rough cutting

Raw materials are transformed into the basic shapes of furniture components. This involves cutting larger pieces of material into component sizes using our modern **CNC panel saw**. The goal at this stage is to press the veneer. This process requires careful planning to minimize waste and ensure safety, setting the foundation for the more detailed work to follow.

3. Veneer

*"Veneer is like clothing to the human body"; it not only enhances the aesthetic appeal but also provides a layer of protection, turning the simple into something spectacular. We try our best to bring customers the most beautiful and creative design. After rough cutting, veneer is then hot pressed by our **Hot pressing machine**.*

PRODUCTION PROCESS and FACILITY

Laminate

Laminate enhances durability and aesthetic appeal. It offers resistance to damage and provides diverse design options, blending practicality and style. After rough cutting, laminate is then cold pressed by our **Cold pressing machine**

Used for pressing and adhering decorative panel surfaces, laminating, and increasing product bonding capabilities.

4. Fine cutting

Unlike rough cutting, fine cutting is focused on precision and detail, shaping the components to their exact dimensions using modern machinery. Every panel is calculated meticulously to ensure pieces match perfectly together in the assembly stage. This step is crucial for maintaining quality and aesthetics of the final product.



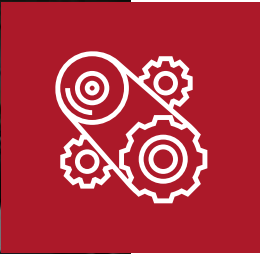

5. Edge banding

Edge banding involves applying a strip of material, often made of wood veneer, PVC or ABS to the exposed edges of furniture pieces made of MDF or plywood board. This process enhances the aesthetics by providing a smooth and cohesive finish, hiding the raw edges that can detract from the overall look of the furniture

6. Fine Millwork

CNC (Computer Numerical Control) Router Cutting is a process where a computer-controlled machine is used to carve, cut, and shape the raw material into precise designs. The technology allows for the production of complex shapes and patterns with high accuracy and consistency. The designs are programmed into the CNC machine using CAD (Computer-Aided Design) software, and the machine executes the designs by controlling the cutting tools along the specified paths.

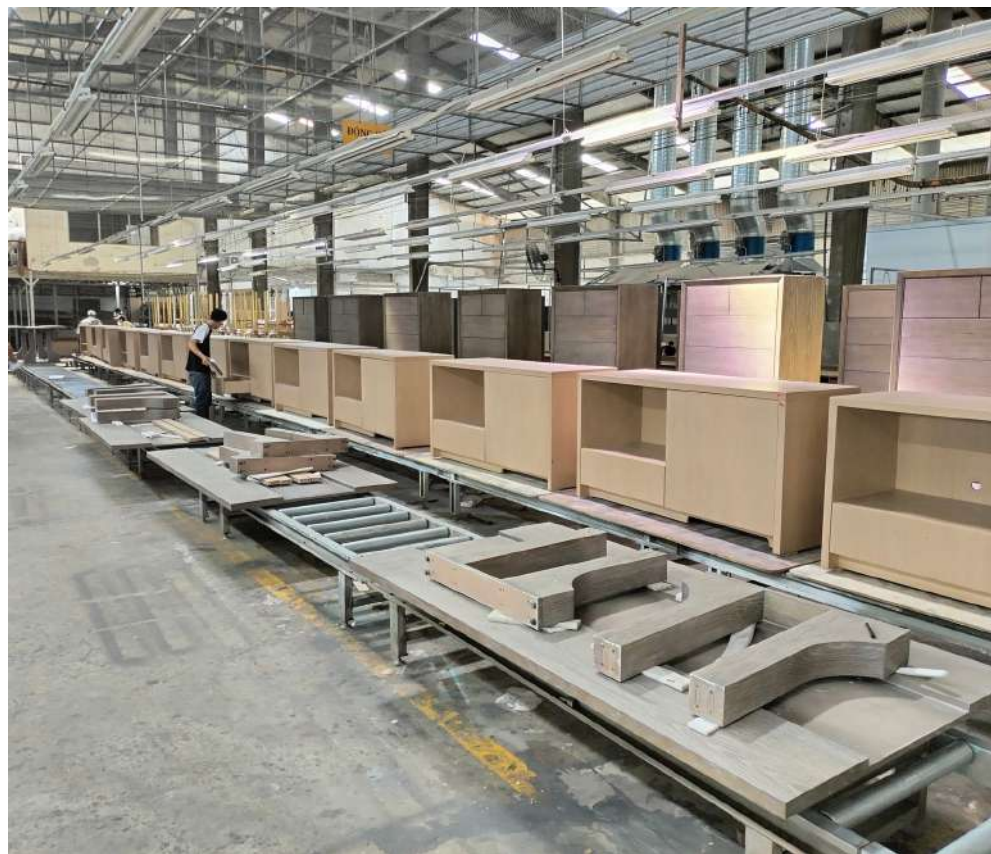
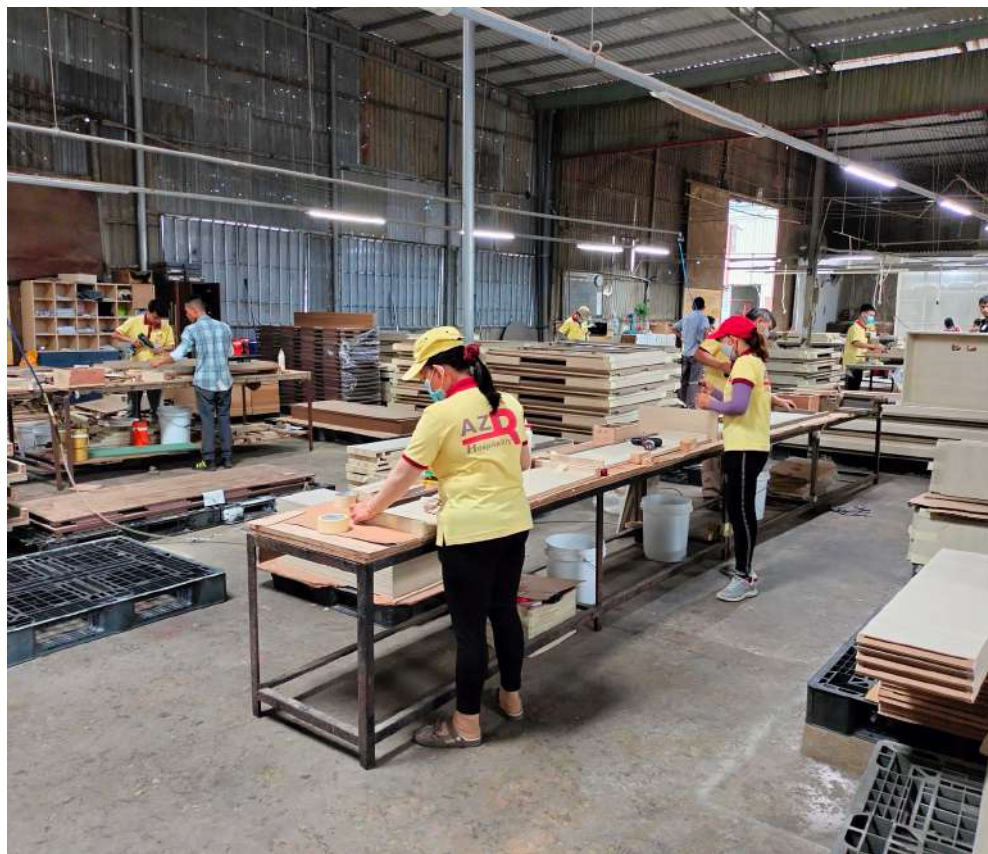
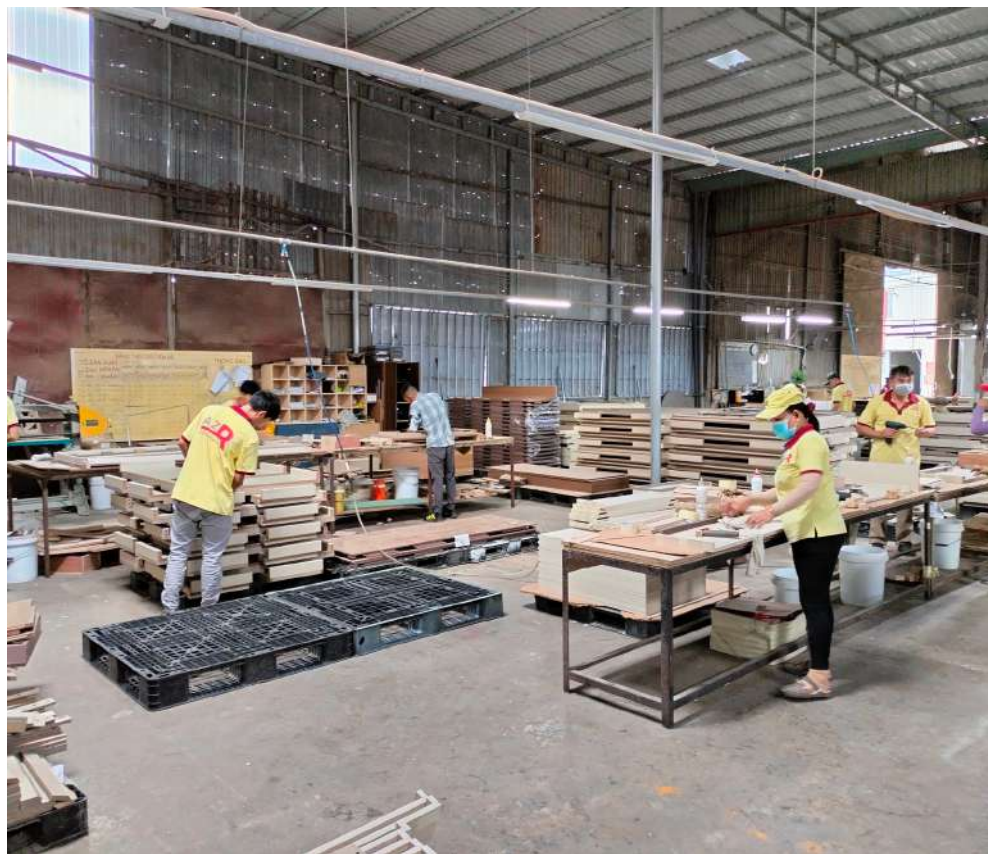
6-SIDED CNC DRILLING MACHINE

7. White wood assembly

In the white wood assembly stage, the meticulously crafted and shaped components are brought together to create the basic structure of the furniture piece. This process involves joining the various parts, often using techniques such as doweling, screws, or adhesives. The aim of preliminary assembly is to ensure that all components fit together as intended, verifying the accuracy of prior manufacturing stages. Any necessary adjustments are made at this stage before proceeding to the finishing stages like painting and final assembly.

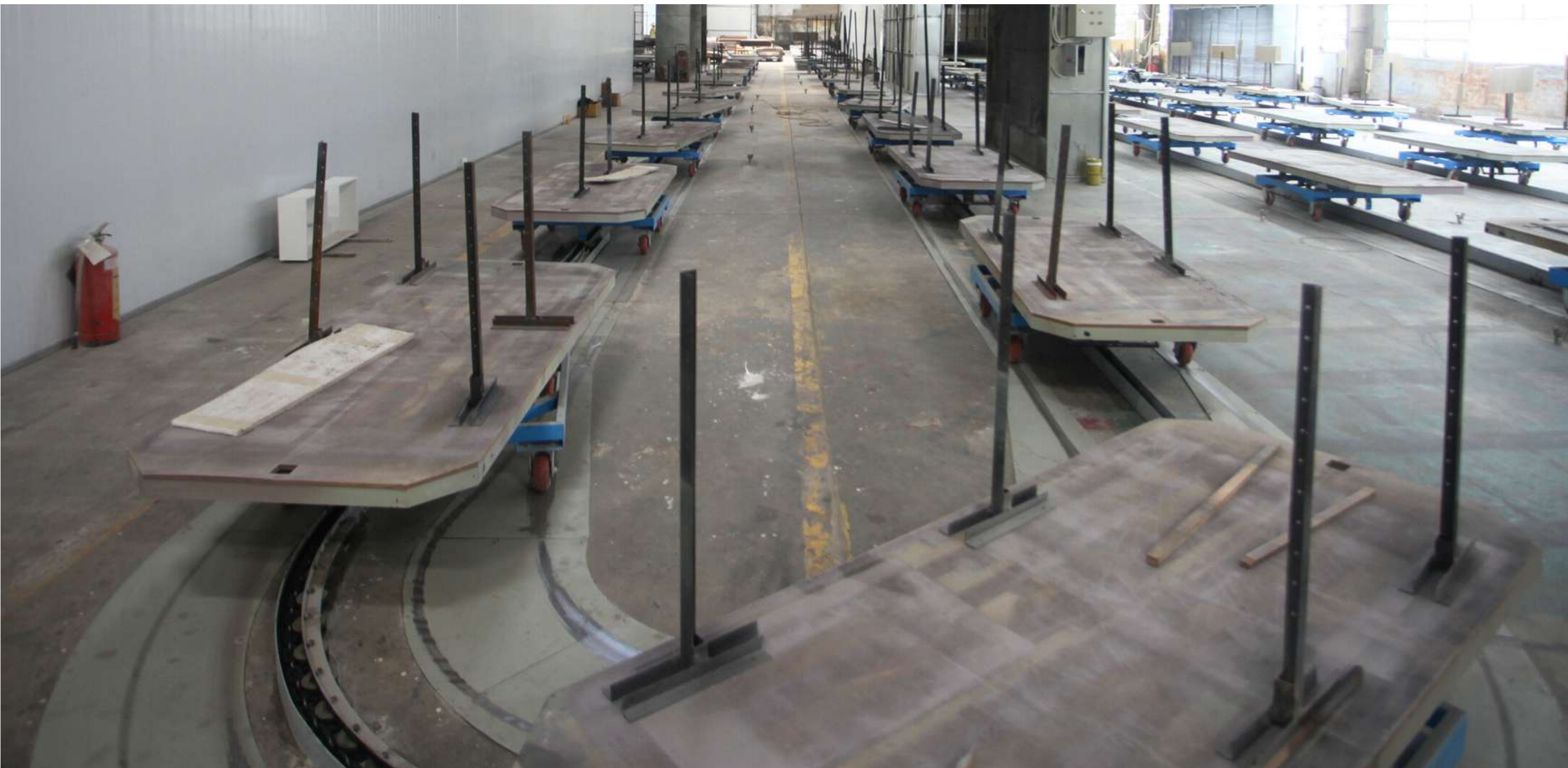
8. Coloring

Coloring is the final encore, where naked timber blossoms into its destined guise. Careful attention is paid to the evenness of application to ensure a smooth and uniform color. Depending on the desired look, multiple coats may be applied, often with sanding in between coats for a high-quality finish. Here is our coloring process with the help of the **Automatic pallet line**

Stain → Sealer 1 → Dry 1 → Sealer 2 → Dry 2 → Shading Color → Topcoat → Dry 3

8. Coloring

UV Coating

UV (Ultraviolet) coating is a highly efficient and eco-friendly finishing process. In this process, a liquid coating is applied to the surface of the furniture and then instantly cured or dried using ultraviolet light from our UV line. The result is a high-gloss, smooth, and durable finish that enhances the furniture's aesthetics and offers superior protection against scratches, abrasion, and fading. We use our state-of-the-art **UV coating line** for solid color or for the semi-finished color

9. Final assembly and Inspection

The final assembly stage involves putting together all the individual parts to complete the furniture piece. This process follows the preliminary assembly and coloring stages. All components, including hardware like hinges, rails, glass, handles, or knobs, are secured in their proper place using methods such as gluing, screwing, or nailing. This step requires precision and care to ensure that the final product is not only aesthetically pleasing but also accurate with the technical drawings. Factory QC will do the final inspection after final assembly to make sure the color, hardware, etc., match exactly as requested before inviting Customer QC to do the final inspection.



Packing

In the packing stage, the final assembled pieces are prepared for safe and secure transportation. The products are wrapped or covered in protective materials, such as bubble wrap to prevent any damage during transit. Depending on the product, it might be boxed, crated, or palletized. Attention is also given to efficient packing to optimize space while maintaining product safety. Labels are applied for easy identification and instructions.
